

CHILD LABOR LAW ENFORCEMENT - 1944

In view of the alarming increase in employment of minors between the ages of 14 and 17, at full or part time work, an increase from 1,000,000 in 1939-1940 to 2,750,000 in 1943-44, the Executive Board of the National Federation of Temple Sisterhoods appeals to the Chairman and members of the Appropriations Committee of the House of Representatives immediately to approve the proposed appropriation of \$369,222 for the Federal Children's Bureau for child labor law enforcement. We urge the units and members of the National Federation of Temple Sisterhoods to take similar action.
