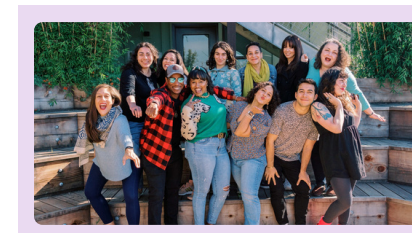
Special Projects
