Mid-Atlantic District is offering scholarships to:

- First time attendees of any URJ [camp](#)*
- Campers with a family connection to a Mid-Atlantic District member (mother or grandmother)
- Camper must reside within the Mid-Atlantic District
- One scholarship per family per year
- Scholarship will cover a maximum of 10% of camp registration.
- Camper agrees to share experiences with their local Jewish community.

* Having participated in Taste of Camp partial sessions does not disqualify the camper

Criteria for youth scholarships to only URJ camps:

1. The child must reside within the Mid-Atlantic District.
2. A member of the child's immediate family must be affiliated with the WRJ Mid-Atlantic District.
3. The camper may only receive a scholarship one time. It must be the first time that the camper has attended a URJ summer camp. **Having attended a partial session meant to be a "Taste of Camp" does not disqualify the camper from receiving a scholarship.**
4. The scholarship will cover 10% of the camp registration fee for one session.
5. Scholarship will be distributed upon confirmation of registration at a URJ camp.
6. Each camper who receives a camp scholarship will be expected to share their camp experience with her/his Jewish community. Examples may include and are not limited to: teaching or tutoring Jewish or Hebrew studies, joining a Reform youth group, encouraging other children to attend a URJ camp or if requested, making a presentation about the experience at a district meeting.
