

INTERNATIONAL DISARMAMENT URGED - 1927

Whereas, the Preparatory Disarmament Commission of the League of Nations is not considering the question on international disarmament, and

Whereas, the United States government is cooperating in the work of this Commission, and

Whereas, the American Delegation has rendered, and can render important service to the Commission, and

Whereas, believing with President Coolidge "That no nation ever had an army large enough to guarantee against attack,"

Therefore, be it resolved, that we, the National Federation of Temple Sisterhoods, in Biennial Convention assembled, write President Coolidge our appreciation of his attitude and our hope of his continued support of the work of the Preparatory Disarmament Commission.
