PEACE EDUCATION - 1938

The world today is confronted with a catastrophe more ominous than at any time since the World War. Ours is a generation called upon to grapple with vast and complex social, economic and political problems. We are living through a cycle of tremendous upheaval—a social revolution of colossal proportions which is none the less real for being unrecognized by individuals.

Therefore, be it resolved, that the Executive Board of the National Federation of Temple Sisterhoods assembled in annual meeting in the city of Chicago, reaffirms its determination to further the cause of peace and democracy through more intensified individual study and through the strengthening of all educational forces which will promote better understanding among men and nations.
