

COMMISSION TO STUDY PROBLEMS OF WORLD ORGANIZATION - 1941

Whereas, the National Federation of Temple Sisterhoods is one of forty member organizations of the National Peace Conference, and

Whereas, Israel's prophetic mission has always been peace,

Be it resolved, that this Assembly endorse in Fourteenth Biennial Convention the recommendation of the Conference that a commission composed of members of the United States Department of State, both Houses of Congress, and responsible private citizens, be established to study the problems of world organization and the possible plans for effective international cooperation in the post-war world.

Furthermore, this endorsement shall be spread upon the records of the National Federation of Temple Sisterhoods and a copy thereof transmitted to President Franklin D. Roosevelt and to Secretary of State Cordell Hull.
