

WRJ's 2019 Social Justice Conference (SJC) on May 17-19, 2019 will be a powerful experience for Jewish women to become better-educated and trained on social justice issues, learn advocacy skills you can utilize at home and on a larger scale, and address timely topics in a welcoming and encouraging, all-female Jewish environment with women of all ages. WRJ will offer a "college cohort" experience for current undergraduate college women to learn social justice skills and information in this unique setting, and connect with one another to create a support system and plan of action for bringing change back to your campus. Our goal is for college students who attend the WRJ Social Justice Conference to establish an enduring relationship with WRJ. We expect students to return from the conference and share their meaningful experiences with others back on their campus, as well as with WRJ/the Reform Movement at large via social media, blogs, etc. **College Cohort women must commit to attending all sessions at SJC 2019.** Although SJC officially begins on Saturday morning with Torah study and worship, we ask that all college attendees arrive by 5:30 p.m. on Friday, May 17, 2019 to check into the hotel and partake in an offsite dinner for SJC young adults (at your own cost) and WRJ's Shabbat services at the hotel, as part of the cohort experience.

To facilitate college women's attendance at SJC, the discount Young Adult registration rate of \$100 (for any woman age 18-30) applies. WRJ will also cover two (2) nights in a shared hotel room for those college women attending SJC who have a financial need (nights covered are only those of SJC: Friday May 17th and Saturday May 18th). Once you have been in touch with wrj.org, you will be asked to fill out a form to submit your SJC hotel needs, by early April. After you complete the form, WRJ will make the hotel reservation for you (you will not need to lay out the cost). We will be in touch closer to SJC to provide you with confirmed hotel details.

Those also staying for the <u>RAC's Consultation on Conscience</u> (May 19-21) will need to register and pay separately for the Consultation registration fee and hotel.
