Protect Trans Students by Marilyn Glazer

Pledge to Take Action to Protect Trans Students

On February 22, 2017 the Trump administration rescinded 2016 federal

guidelines instructing public schools to create inclusive environments for transgender and gender non-conforming students, including ensuring access to restrooms and other facilities based on each student's gender identity. Reform Movement leaders from the RAC, Union for Reform Judaism and Central Conference of American Rabbis condemned the rollback of these key protections, calling it a "serious step backward in the effort to protect transgender youth—and, more broadly, in the march toward equal civil rights for all Americans."
