
How can you experience community? Participate in the upcoming events listed in theUPCOMING EVENTS section below.

Opening Adoption Records and Obtaining Original Birth Certificates

The documentary <u>A Simple Piece of Paper</u> tells the story of individuals who were able to obtain their original birth certificate and what it meant to them. Illinois State Representative Sara Feigenholtz, a Jewish woman and herself an adoptee, was responsible for the passage of HB5428, The Original Birth Certificate Access Bill, which was signed into law in 2011, details of which is below. Sara recently connected with two sisters that she did not previously know that she had.

HB5428, the Original Birth Certificate Access Bill, has been signed into law! Please visit the <u>Illinois Vital Records Website</u> to obtain a request form. Individuals born before 1946 can begin requesting the form today, and individuals born on or after January 1, 1946 can fill out the form beginning November 15, 2011.


