I am still so exhilarated by everything about our recent Midwest District Convention! I hope that everyone who attended agrees that the warm and welcoming enthusiasm of every individual volunteer, sisterhood and district leader, as well as the quality of the speakers and services, created ruach for the entire weekend.

There are many to thank, and we thanked them profusely! But I can't say too often what an incredible job the four co-chairs (**Carol Berger, Michelle Scheinkopf, Cheryl Stern** and **Linn Ullenbrauck**) did to create one of our most successful conventions ever. Their 2-year effort resulted in:

- 120 full weekend/day registered attendees.
- Over 200 individuals who attended one or more programs.
- Representation from 28 of our 33 sisterhoods.
- More than \$6,000 donated to WRJ's YES Fund.

There were so many incredible programs and workshops, but here is what moved me:

- The services. Friday night service at Etz Chaim, where we presented their sisterhood with their charter and gavel in front of their entire congregation; a Saturday morning service of music, poetry and prayer led by Marla Goldberg and Cantor Rachel Rosenberg; and our installation service coordinated by Judy Wexler, with our first ever convention choir led by Karen Dillon, and installation blessings and Havdalah led by "my Rabbi Ike", Isaac Serotta.
- The Kavod Luncheon. 190 participants honored the achievements of our sisterhoods and women of valor.
- The Mensch Panel. Rozan Anderson facilitated a panel of nonprofit leaders whose community outreach programs are making a real difference in the world.
- WRJ Vice President Sara Charney. Sara was an incredible resource in planning the convention and provided essential information to our

attendees about WRJ. More importantly, she became a wonderful friend to many of us.

Perhaps the most moving part of the weekend for me was the time we spent laughing together and crying together. We thanked **Lynne Turry**, and shed a few tears with her, for all she has done for Midwest District and for her fortitude and commitment to be with us. I thank Lynne for being my mentor, teacher, and partner in efforts to support WRJ and our members.

And we laughed with new **First Vice President Michelle Scheinkopf** and her complimentary skill set in all things related to pins and wrapping paper. Seriously, I know, and you will know if you don't already, that Michelle is wise and funny, calm and passionate. She always puts the people side of issues first. I couldn't ask for a better partner in leading WRJ Midwest District.
