- Re: Your sisterhood/women's group may be eligible to apply for a scholarship to the WRJ Northeast District Convention in Framingham, MA, October 25-28, 2018.

WRJ Northeast District's upcoming Sixth Biennial Convention, "Ten Years Together – Growing Our Community," offers an opportunity for members from your sisterhood/women's group to create a special bond with women from throughout the Northeast District who share the same interests, concerns, and love of Reform Judaism. Women who attend the convention will enhance their leadership skills, expand their Jewish knowledge, and be able to interact with and learn from our WRJ guest Jane Taves, vice president of Women of Reform Judaism, as well as several additional WRJ and WRJ Northeast District leaders.

We are delighted to inform you that the WRJ Northeast District Executive Committee has approved scholarships for the WRJ Northeast District Convention in Framingham, MA. Sisterhoods/women's groups that receive a scholarship will be awarded the \$125 early bird registration fee, which covers programming and materials. The scholarships are being funded by Our Founding Mother's Fund.

The primary motivation behind creating these scholarships is to help sisterhoods/women's groups that haven't been able to send a representative to a convention in the recent past. Up to ten Northeast District sisterhoods/ women's groups will be able to receive these scholarships. Each eligible sisterhood/women's group may apply for only one scholarship. However, sisterhoods/women's groups receiving a scholarship have the option of dividing the money among two or more registrants.

Any sisterhood/women's group that did not attend the convention in 2016 and is in good standing with WRJ and the Northeast District is eligible to apply for a scholarship. Additionally, scholarship recipients must attend at least two days of the convention. Reimbursement for the registration fee will be sent to the sisterhood/women's group shortly after the convention.

The scholarship application is attached. Sisterhood presidents/women's group leaders should complete the application on behalf of their sisterhood/women's group and return it via email to Jane Sanders and Barbara Prins (jrs0991@gmail.com and bep439@optonline.net) no later than Sunday, September 9, 2018. Receipt of the application will be acknowledged by email. Notification of scholarship awards will be sent via email by Friday, September 14, 2108. Early Bird Registration closes Sunday, September 16, 2018.

Sisterhoods/women's groups that receive a scholarship must notify Jane Sanders and Barbara Prins, by Wednesday, September 26, 2018, with the name of the woman or women who will be using the scholarship. Scholarship recipients cannot be members of the Northeast District Board. However, women who are board members by virtue of being sisterhood presidents/women's group leaders are exempted from this restriction, and are eligible to apply. Sisterhoods/women's groups will receive the reimbursement for the registration fee shortly after the convention.

Please take advantage of this opportunity to ensure that YOUR sisterhood/women's group is represented at the WRJ Northeast District Convention.
